The project

The goal of the MANAGE CARE project is to develop an innovative Chronic Care Model with applicable standards for clinical pathways as well as guidelines and training curricula for healthcare professionals using these standards.

MANAGE CARE is one of the largest public health projects in the chronic care sector funded by the European Commission. It consists of 37 partners covering nearly the whole European Union, and a wide spectrum of expertise and stakeholders in the field of diabetes-related chronic care management.



Results and impact

The MANAGE CARE study has ended in May 2016 producing a number of deliverables

- a patient empowerment booklet (currently in ten languages)
- a European Practice Compendium on Disease Management
- The MANAGE CARE Model and 11 recommendations to improve chronic care management
- an e-health portal (http://mdl-mcare.instruct.eu) and implications for communicative competences
